Pakistan Updates



The Pakistan Special Education Initiative continues to make great progress to improve special education resources in Pakistan. Through their school collaborations and partnerships, PSEI continues to invest in the future of students with special needs across the country.

Exciting progress was made this quarter! Innovative and inspiring projects allow PSEI to continue the amazing impact they are making. Cresent Model School in Lahore co-hosted a soft launch event at their campus for the Initial Assessment Tool (IAT). The IAT is a resource used to screen learning disabilities in mainstream classroom, something that can revolutionise special education in Pakistan.

'Before PSEI, mainstream classrooms often overlooked children with learning disabilities. PSEI's intervention addresses this gap, providing mechanisms to identify learning disabilities early and help SEND children reach their full potential'- Mr Altaf Saleem, Managing Trustee & Secretary at Cresent Educational Trust.

In January, Our Executive Director, Tariq Raja, embarked on a trip to Pakistan to witness first-hand what we continue to achieve through our partnerships and programmes overseas. There is a lot to be excited about in 2025 and beyond!

Community Grants





Our Community Grants endeavors to support CareTech Ltd staff, their families and local communities in hopes to enrich the areas where CareTech Ltd operates. This quarter we granted a total of **15 grants**, amounting to over **£16,000**.

The Community Grants have been KICKING off this quarter... The Stafford Atletico under 7's football team recognise the importance of fostering an environment where their team feels valued, included and empowered.

Over the winter, their training was interrupted due to poor weather conditions and many players had been playing in outgrown kits. A grant of £750 from the Foundation funded indoor facilities and kits to allow the team to play consistently and with pride!

Staff Hardship Funds

The Foundation receives a restricted donation from CareTech Ltd to enable us to offer small grants of up to £1,500 to both current staff and those who have recently left the company and are facing significant financial hardship or are at risk of experiencing such hardship.

In the most recent quarter, the Foundation awarded a total of **79 grants**, amounting to over £50,000, to individuals in need of financial support.

TFSL is an organisation offering crucial support to the families and carers of young people with life limiting conditions to help them make the most of every moment together.

We are proud to partner with TFSL and support this amazing work with a grant of £225,000! This will provide families with access to support and professionals access to training and resources.

One of TFSL's exciting projects is their outreach events which raise awareness, enable training and create memory making. With our grant, TFSL will be able to fund 20 events across the UK, share resources, build support networks and ensure no one experiences loss alone.

The impact that this partnership will have, is amazing. We hope to see improved mental wellbeing of families meaning they can spend more time together with less pressure.
